SHORT SYNOPSIS

Praying for Armageddon is a political thriller that reveals the power and influence of U.S. fundamentalist Evangelicals, as they aim to fulfill the Armageddon prophecy. With close quarters journalism, this feature documentary embeds with American believers who prepare for The Holy war and exposes how powerful megachurch pastors call for the 'final battle' that they believe will trigger the Second Coming of Christ. A deep dive into power and policy, this film unveils how politicians driven by faith embrace Israel as the key to their prophetic vision for the end of days. At any cost.

Praying for Armageddon investigates the dangerous consequences of the fusion between Evangelical Christianity and American politics. Stark and gripping in approach, this film not only reveals how structures of fundamentalism weaken the very fabric of American democracy, but also highlights the devastating impact religion wields on U.S. foreign policy. Praying for Armageddon uncovers how the Evangelicals fuel the volatile situation in Israel and Palestine - ultimately escalating the spirals of violence in the Middle East.

Tonje Hessen Schei DIRECTOR

Tonje Hessen Schei is an award-winning Norwegian filmmaker that takes on international issues of power that shape our world. Her films *Praying for Armageddon* (2023), *iHuman* (2019), *Drone* (2014), *Play Again* (2010) have received numerous national and international awards, and have screened at the UN and EU parliaments, Netflix and major film festivals worldwide.

Through telling strong human stories that front the zeitgeist of our time, Tonje is lauded for giving complex issues a human face. Her work has been described as both visionary and entertaining. Tonje is a TEDx Speaker, and the recipient of the Chicken & Egg Award 2020.

KEY TEAM

Co-director and cinematographer **MICHAEL ROWLEY** (USA) is an award-winning director, cinematographer, and editor living in Dallas, Texas. Rowley's work has been characterized as defiant, visceral, and deeply human. His voice has earned him the Austin Film Society's North Texas Pioneer Film Grant twice and four festival jury awards for exceptional work. Rowley's feature directorial debut, *Hurdle* (2019), screened across the international film festival circuit and featured in publications like The New York Times and Variety. *Hurdle* is distributed by TVF International and New Day Films and was acquired for streaming by SundanceNow.



Editor **TORKEL GJØRV** (Norway) is one of Norway's most experienced documentary editors. He has been the editor of a number of award-winning films and documentary series. His films include *iHuman*, *Inside Fur*, *Aleppo's Fall* and *Reunion: 10 Years After The War*. They have been screened nationally and internationally and received several awards, including the Amanda, the Norwegian equivalent of the Oscar.

Composer **UNO HELMERSSON** (Sweden) is an award-winning composer and a multi-instrumentalist whose credits include the worldwide hit TV series *The Bridge*, broadcast in more than 100 territories. He was awarded a Golden FIPA for his work in the series. A graduate of the Royal Academy of Music in Stockholm, Uno has released a multitude of albums throughout his career. Among the films he has composed music for are *Armadillo*, *The Painter And The Thief*, *The Distant Barking Of Dogs* and many more.

Executive Producer HUSSAIN CURRIMBHOY (Sweden/Canada) has worked in the film industry since graduating from the Victorian College of Art in 2002. A passion for international cinema lead Hussain to program for the Melbourne International Film Festival, and later moved on to program and curate films for festivals like Brisbane Int. Film Festival and the Adelaide Film Festival before joining England's Sheffield Doc/Fest as director of programming. By 2014, Hussain moved to Los Angeles to join Sundance Film Festival as lead documentary and VR programmer. After contracts as guest programmer for Nordisk Panorama, FoodxFilm Festival and the Red Sea Int. Film Festival, Hussain relocated to Sweden to develop a focus in filmmaking. Most recently he has been appointed Director, Global Project Development/Investment for the Chicago Media Project.

Executive Producer **SUE TURLEY** (USA) is an industry veteran and the Senior Vice President for Development, Production and Strategic Partnerships for XRM Media, responsible for XRM's interests in all areas of

content-related initiatives and activities. Prior to this, Sue was the Managing Director for Ro*Co Films where she created new production pipelines and provided financing access to support emerging filmmakers. She has a strong track record in producing and distributing award winning and Oscar nominated projects, such as *Beyond Utopia*, *The YouTube Effect*, *Riotsville U.S.A, Born Into Brothels*, and *Life*, *Animated*.

Based in Norway, **UpNorth Film** is one of the most prominent documentary producton companies in Scandinavia. Their films has won several awards, been screened on Netflix, BBC and broadcasters worldwide, has had theatrical releases in several countries and been invited to prominent festvals on all continents.
